No cooking or the use of sterno (canned heat) or gas burners shall be allowed inside of the Maui War Memorial Complex. 7. Food must be prepared in a certified kitchen. 8. Food vendors must obtain a Dept. of Health permit and submit a copy to MEO along with the application and payment. 9. Vendors selling food or items, or administering shots, must provide a certificate of insurance for \$1,000,000 naming MEO as an additional insured on the policy. Senior Clubs who pay P&CC membership dues are covered under MEO's policy and are not required to obtain additional insurance. 10.
