1. Tables will be assigned on a FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVE PAID BASIS by the Fair Committee.
2. The committee may deny applications that are duplicative or over table space limitations.
3. Vendors will **not** be allowed to select their own table.
4. Vendors will be notified of items disapproved for sale upon receipt of the application.
5. Participation fee includes one (1) 8-foot table, tablecloth and skirt, and two (2) chairs.
6. No cooking or the use of sterno (canned heat) or gas burners shall be allowed inside of the Maui War Memorial Complex.
7. Food must be prepared in a certified kitchen.
8. Food vendors must obtain a Dept. of Health permit and submit a copy to MEO along with the application and payment.
9. Vendors selling food or items, or administering shots, must provide a certificate of insurance for \$1,000,000 naming MEO as an additional insured on the policy. *Senior Clubs who pay P&CC membership dues are covered under MEO's policy and are not required to obtain additional insurance.*
10. No sales of any kind will be permitted prior to the start of the Fair at 7:30 a.m.
11. No selling of beverages (coffee, soda, tea, water, etc.)
