**Terms and Conditions**

Project Graduation Administration shall be responsible for the following:

- Obtaining Student applications from all students signed by students and parent/guardian. All applications must be turned in to MEO.
- Determining eligibility for subsidy. Following 2018 income guidelines.
- Subsidy will be applied to the total cost for the individual to attend, plus any out of pocket participation fee.  
For example – Cost per student is \$500.00 without subsidy, but due to fundraising and donations, each student only needs to pay \$100.00. Each low income student qualifies for the \$500.00 subsidy and pays nothing out of pocket. Remaining grant funds subsidizes all remaining students.
