NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC
INDIVIDUALS' RIGHTS UNDER TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT
2016

IT'S IS THE LAW

Maui Economic Opportunity, Inc., a recipient of federal financial assistance, operates its programs and services without regard to race, color and national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU BELIEVE YOU HAVE EXPERIENCED DISCRIMINATION

Any person who believes that she or he has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI must file a complaint within 180 days of the alleged occurrence to any of the following:

If you file a complaint with MEO or the State, you must wait either until the recipient issues a written Notice of Final Action, or until 90 days have passed (whichever is sooner), before filing with the Federal Transit Administration (see address above.)

If the recipient does not give you a written Notice of Final Action within 90 days of the date on which you filed your complaint, you do not have to wait for the recipient to issue that Notice before filing a complaint with the FTA. However, you must file your FTA complaint within 30 days of the 90-day deadline (in other words, within 120 days after the day on which you filed your complaint with the recipient).

If the recipient does give you a written Notice of Final Action on your complaint, but you are dissatisfied with the decision or resolution, you may file a complaint with the FTA. You must file your FTA complaint within 30 days of the date on which you receive the Notice of Final Action.
